



Code of Conduct for all Members

Upon applying for and being accepted as a Member of the Club, the Member shall unconditionally agree to the following Code of Conduct:

1. Undertake to be financial at all times.
2. Shall not behave in a manner that is prejudicial to the good reputation or future of the Club.
3. Shall not act in a manner as to contravene the current Transport Operations Road Use Management Act (TORUMS) 1995 and Transport Operations (Road Rules) Regulation 1999 or any other State or Territory Act or Regulation whilst involved in Club conducted activities in that State or Territory.
4. Shall accept and abide by all lawful directives and requirements of the Committee as amended from time to time.
5. Shall unconditionally respect all fellow Members and in so doing shall not act in a threatening manner be it physical and/or otherwise.
6. Shall not financially benefit from his or her Membership of the Club save and except where such business enterprise is known and made known to the Committee at the time of the Members application for Membership or thereafter and before any financial benefit accrues to the member. (This does not exclude members receiving financial gain that may pass to any member due to Club membership, such as sponsor provided discounts and the like.)
7. A Member from time to time may be contracted to provide specific services to the Club by the Committee and such services shall be provided on the basis of normal commercial terms save and except where there is a specific agreement in writing between the Member and the Committee prior to the execution of such service.
8. By virtue of his or her Membership acceptance agrees to act as an ambassador of the Club and in the best interests of the Club at all times.
9. Shall not make representations or public statements for and on behalf of the Club without prior written consent from the Committee.
10. Membership of the Club is conditional upon each Member being held accountable for their actions where such actions are found to be in contravention of any and/or all of the above stated requirements then the said Member may be liable to disciplinary action in accordance with the Club's Constitution.
11. Where this Code of Conduct conflicts with the Club Constitution, the Club Constitution will prevail.
